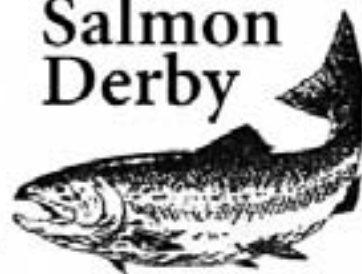

## WEIGH STATIONS

Weigh stations have tickets Saturday **ONLY**

- **Freshwater Bay Boat Ramp** ['A' on map]  
Off Rt. 112, near Joyce
- **Ediz Hook Boat Ramp** ['B' on map]  
Near Coast Guard Station at end of hook
- **John Wayne Marina** ['C' on map]  
On West Sequim Bay Rd., near Rt. 101
- **Gardiner Boat Ramp** ['D' on map]  
On Gardiner Beach Rd., near Rt. 101
- **Port Townsend Boat Haven** ['E' on map]  
At Boat Haven gas dock (Fish'n Hole)
- Check our website for launch fees, if any.

## FISHING GUIDELINES

- Catch/submit fish **only during Derby hours** (see "Schedule" in this brochure).
- Fish only in area boundaries (see map).
- Please submit **every legal fish** you keep – you might win the "Mystery Fish" prize!
- ◆ Please consider **donating fish** to our community's annual Appreciation Dinner.
- All fish will be **returned after weighing** – no cleaning and storage this year.
- VHF channel **68**: Derby announcements.
- VHF channel **16**: Emergencies.
- You are responsible for conforming to all **state/federal rules**, such as:
  - § Valid fishing license required
  - § Only one fishing pole per person
  - § Pole to be hand-held while landing fish
  - § No stationary poles (or facsimiles)
  - § Single point barbless hooks only
  - § Maintain required safety equipment
  - § Avoid Protection Island (200 yard limit)

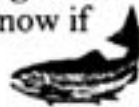
**SELECTIVE FISHERY – "CLIPPED FIN TO WIN"**

## RULES (PLEASE READ!)

1. **Tickets.** a) Derby tickets cost \$40 per person for 1 or all 3 days. b) Participants must have a current Derby ticket prior to fishing. (There are no stickers.) c) **Each person** on vessel must have a ticket on hand, **whether fishing or not** and regardless of age. Every legal pole in the boat needs its own ticket. d) All Derby ticket holders are eligible to fish, including officials.
2. **Fishing.** a) You must comply with "Fishing Guidelines" in this brochure. b) You are responsible for complying with all Washington State, Coast Guard, and other applicable rules. c) Entire Derby is **Selective Fishery only** ("clipped fin").
3. **Submitting fish.** a) Only **legal clipped-fin Chinook/Blackmouth salmon at least 22 inches long** submitted during Derby hours with all required data are eligible for prizes. b) Fish must be transported **by boat (via water)** to an official Derby weigh station (at each launch ramp; see "Weigh Stations" in this brochure). A Derby official will log in each catch. A fish biologist will be on hand to check fish. c) All fish are returned immediately (no storage or display) unless you choose to **donate a fish to the annual Derby Appreciation Dinner (thanks!)**.
4. **Awards ceremony.** a) See "Schedule" in this brochure for time and location. b) **Prizes should be claimed** at the awards ceremony by presenting your ticket. If you are unable to attend, you may turn over your ticket to a representative to collect your prize. c) Derby officials will **try to contact absent winners** after the Derby. Unclaimed prizes will be distributed as we see fit.
5. **Prizes.** a) You do **NOT need** to be present to win a prize (but you can **ONLY** win if your ticket is legible and you meet all requirements). b) Top cash prizes are described in this brochure; other prizes as listed on website may change. c) First fish recorded at a given weight wins a tie; a coin toss decides identical times. **EVERY legal fish** submitted has a chance to be the "Mystery Fish"! d) All ticket holders will be entered in 2011 Northwest Salmon Derby Series boat giveaway (see website for details). e) At most one "ladder" prize (based on size of fish) is awarded per entrant, regardless of number of fish submitted. (However the "Mystery Fish" or any other bonus prizes may be won in addition to a "ladder prize.") f) Prizes are **awarded at the Award Ceremony** and are final, regardless of errors. Any preliminary standings are for amusement only. g) Prizes worth \$600 or more are **ONLY** awarded after providing required tax information, and may be sent by mail shortly after the Derby.
6. **Responsibility.** a) You enter or assist with the Derby at your own risk. You agree to hold Gardiner Salmon Derby Association, volunteers, sponsors, and representatives harmless for any damages, and waive all claims against them. In particular, by choosing to participate, **you agree that fishing is inherently dangerous and that you accept responsibility for your own safety and for any damage you may do or experience.** b) This Derby is independent of the Northwest Marine Trade Association (sponsor of Northwest Salmon Derby Series), which is responsible for all Series matters including boat giveaways. c) The Derby is **not responsible for errors or accidents**, nor for any announced or unannounced **changes in rules, schedules, or policies.** d) Derby officials have **final word on any disputes** about Derby rules, awarding of prizes, or other Derby matters. Please remember that we are all volunteers supporting a charity. e) If you observe a **violation of Derby Rules**, report it immediately to Derby officials via VHF channel 68. Derby officials reserve the right to deny violators prizes and/or bar violators from future competition.

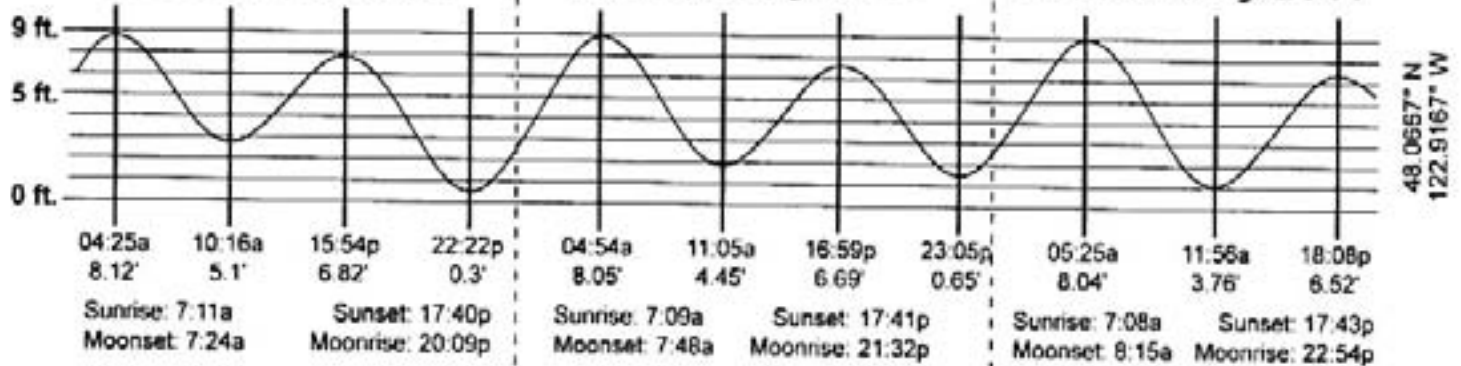

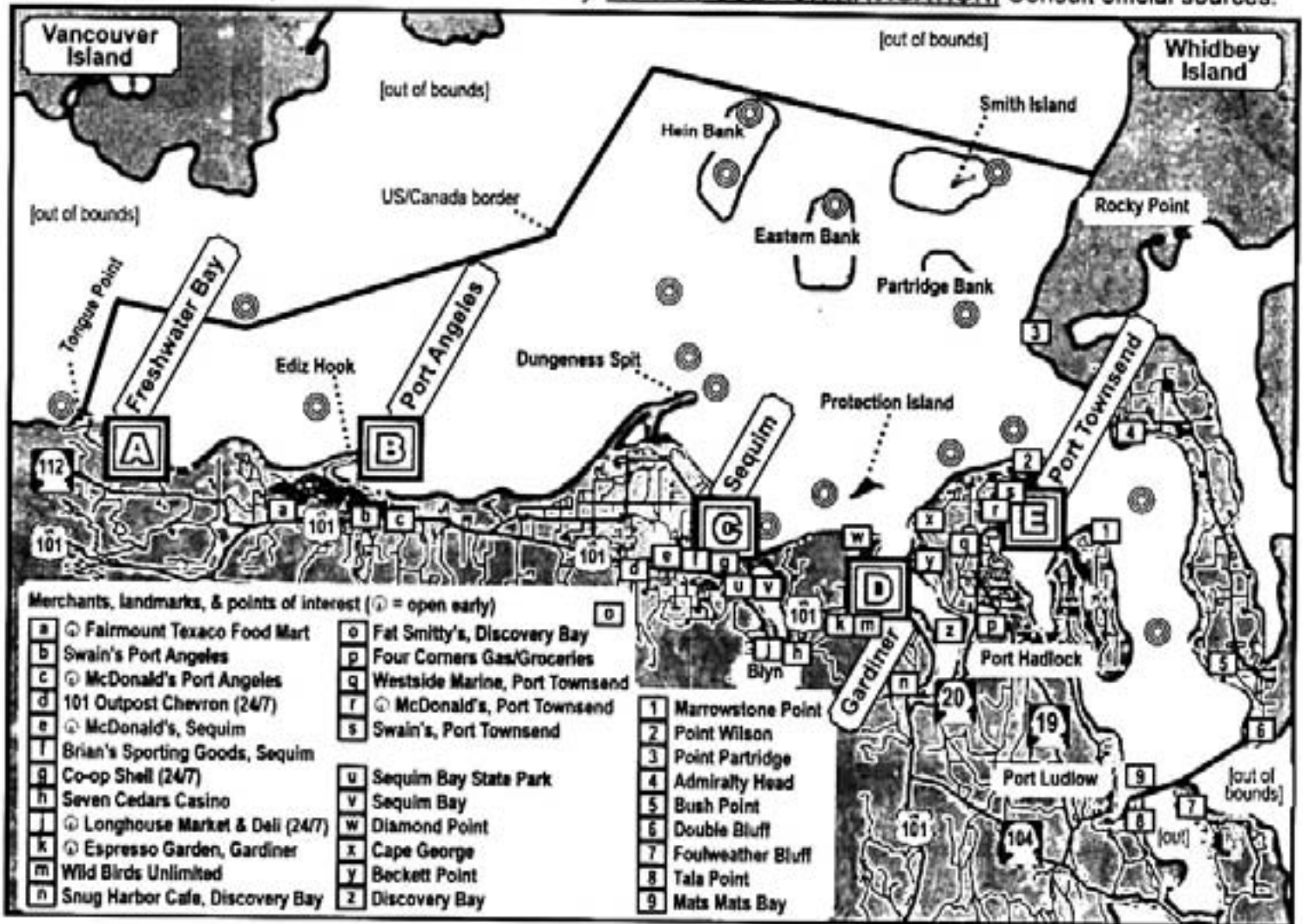

From Tongue Point  
 ...to U.S./Canada border  
 (via bearing on Beachy Head, app. 12° or N by NE)  
 ...to a point W by NE of north buoy at Hein Bank  
 ...to Rocky Point on Whidbey Island  
 (via bearing on Rocky Point via buoy, app. 102° or E by SE)

From Double Bluff (Whidbey Island)  
 ...to Foul Weather Bluff (Kitsap)  
 ...to Tala Point

Fish only in shaded area. Lines run outside marker buoys.
